Volleyball Signs Concordia Academy Pair Fri, Mar 11, 2011 - [Volleyball]

Jamestown College head volleyball coach Jon Hegerle announces **Amanda Kramer** and **Naomi Walther** of Concordia Academy, Roseville, Minn., have signed Dakota Athletic Conference Letters of Intent to enroll at Jamestown College and play volleyball for the Jimmies.

Kramer, a five-foot-five defensive specialist, recorded 442 digs, 98 aces and 43 kills her senior season. She is a two-time All-Conference selection and four-year varsity starter.

"Amanda is a passionate, enthusiastic and competitive athlete," Hegerle says. "Her experiences at Concordia Academy and in Club Volleyball have prepared her in the on-court and off-court skills of being a productive and positive team contributor. Her whole-hearted approach to life fits our philosophy and we are excited to have her on campus to begin her journey as a Jimmie."

Kramer has also been active in basketball and softball. She plans to major in psychology at Jamestown College. She is the daughter of Garrett and Denise Kramer of Maplewood.

Walther, a five-foot-eleven middle blocker/outside hitter, is a two-time All-Conference selection as well as a MN Preps Player of the Week and SAF Sport Enterprises Player of the Week. She recorded 237 kills, 85 blocks, 84 digs and 65 aces her senior season.

"Naomi is a gifted young woman who has a complete understanding what it means to be a leader and contributor to a team," Hegerle says. "Her faith and approach to life will certainly lead to success in all of her endeavors and we are thrilled that she has decided to make Jamestown College her home and the Jimmie Volleyball team her family for the next four years."
